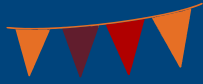

Impact Story: The Power of Showing Up

This month, we are proud to highlight the extraordinary advocacy of CASA Volunteer Melissa Hendricks, whose commitment and consistency made a meaningful difference in the life of a teenager navigating her first year of high school. Melissa was appointed to this youth's case only a few months ago. Yet, she made an immediate impact by doing what CASA advocates do best—showing up, listening deeply, and building trust. In that short time, Melissa became a steady and reliable adult in her youth's life, someone she could talk to and feel genuinely heard by. That bond proved invaluable when the youth experienced a frightening situation and was unable to reach her caseworker.

The first person she turned to was Melissa. Because of Melissa's presence and responsiveness, she quickly contacted her Advocate Supervisor, filed a hotline report, and ensured the youth's safety until formal support could step in. As a result, the agency was able to move the youth to a safer placement the very next day. This story is a powerful reminder of why CASA matters. Sometimes, the most transformational thing we can offer a child is simply being a consistent, caring adult they can depend on. Melissa's dedication provided safety, stability, and reassurance in a moment when it was needed most.

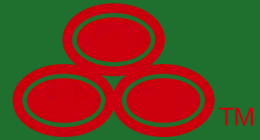
